The NSW State Election will be held on Saturday the 26th of March 2011.

If you live in NSW it is compulsory to vote, so now is the time to **check your enrolment details**

If you are unable to vote on polling day because:

- you are vision impaired or physically incapacitated and unable to vote without assistance,
- you have difficulty voting at a polling place because you have a disability,
- your place of living is not within 20km of a polling place,
- you will not be in NSW throughout the hours of polling on election day... then you may be eligible for iVote.

**iVote is an Electronic Voting System** that lets you vote using the telephone or the internet.
